**NOTICE REGARDING AMENDMENT TO FEDERAL RULE OF BANKRUPTCY
PROCEDURE 3002 (c) (7) AND NEW CM/ECF EVENT CODE**

The December 1, 2017, amendment to Federal Rule of Bankruptcy Procedure 3002(c) (7) provides a two stage deadline for filing a mortgage proof of claim secured by an interest in the debtor's principal residence in a Chapter 7, Chapter 12 or Chapter 13 case. Under this rule, a proof of claim secured by an interest in the debtor's principal residence will be deemed timely filed if, under Rule 3002(c)(7)(A), the proof of claim is filed within 70 days after the order for relief and, under Rule 3002(c)(7)(B), any attachments required by Rule 3001(c)(1) and (d) are filed as a supplement to the proof of claim within 120 days after the order for relief.

Any attachments that are filed as supplement to the proof of claim under Rule 3002(c)(7)(B) must be filed in the Court's CM/ECF system in the main bankruptcy case, not the claims register, and must be filed with a new event code, *Proof of Claim Attachment 3001(c)(1)(d)*. This event code can be found under Bankruptcy in the following categories: 1) Claim Actions, 2) Creditor Claimant Events, and 3) Transfer Creditor Claimant Events. Attachments properly filed under this event code will automatically spread from the docket in the main bankruptcy case to the claims register.
