ORDER REFLECTING AMENDED TERMS OF TENTATIVE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF DETROIT AND THE DETROIT POLICE OFFICERS ASSOCIATION REGARDING PLAN OF ADJUSTMENT

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

- 1. The Stipulation is APPROVED.
- 2. The DPOA shall be permitted to re-file the DPOA Objections if the DPOA membership does not ratify a collective bargaining agreement by August 1, 2014.
- 3. If the DPOA membership does not ratify a collective bargaining agreement by August 1, 2014, then (a) any Class 14 Ballot(s) that accept(s) the Plan submitted by the DPOA will not be counted for purposes of determining whether Class 14 has accepted the Plan in accordance with section 1126(c) of the Bankruptcy Code; and (b) the Claims and Balloting Agent will File, no later than August 11, 2014, a revised tabulation affidavit with respect to Class 14 reflecting the exclusion of the DPOA Class 14 Ballot(s).
- 4. The terms of the Court's Order Reflecting Terms of Tentative Agreement
 Between the City of Detroit and the Detroit Police Officers Association Regarding
 Plan of Adjustment (Docket No. 5922) shall remain in effect except as modified by
 this Order.
