NOTICE REGARDING THE BANKRUPTCY NOTICING CENTER DELIVERY TO CANADA

The recent postal worker strike in Canada has impacted Bankruptcy Noticing Center (BNC) delivery to Canadian recipients. Specifically, Canadian recipients have not received United States Bankruptcy Court notices since November 15, 2024. The BNC has attempted delivery, but all notices are being held at the Canada/U.S. border and will not be delivered until the postal strike ends.

As a reminder, electronic bankruptcy noticing through the BNC (email) is not an option for international recipients.

Counsel may want to consider the service challenges resulting from the postal worker strike for any Canadian entity or opposing party residing in Canada.
